

When visiting Rome during the *Year of Faith*, please join us for the celebration of Holy Mass in **English**, offered every Sunday at the Church of *Santo Spirito in Sassia*, 10:00 a.m. The Church of *Santo Spirito in Sassia* is only three blocks from St. Peter's Square on *Borgo Santo Spirito*, 3 and has been hosting pilgrims to Rome since the 8th century.


The first Mass will be on Sunday, October 14, and is being sponsored by the Pontifical Council for the Promotion of the New Evangelization, in collaboration with the Bishops' Office for United States Visitors to the Vatican, the Pontifical North American College, and the Church of *Santo Spirito in Sassia*.

While in the Eternal City of Rome, you will have the opportunity to join us for the celebration of the Eucharist: “a taste of eternity in time... a communion with the eternal.” (Blessed John Paul II, General Audience, October 25, 2000).

For us men and for our salvation he came down from heaven, and by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. I believe in one, holy, catholic, and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.'

If you are planning your pilgrimage to St. Peter's Tomb during the Year of Faith and would like to attend Holy Mass in English, please print this prayer card and bring it with you. On the back is printed the Creed, the official prayer for the Year of Faith. One of the hopes for the Year of Faith is that the Creed once again become the daily prayer of each Catholic.
